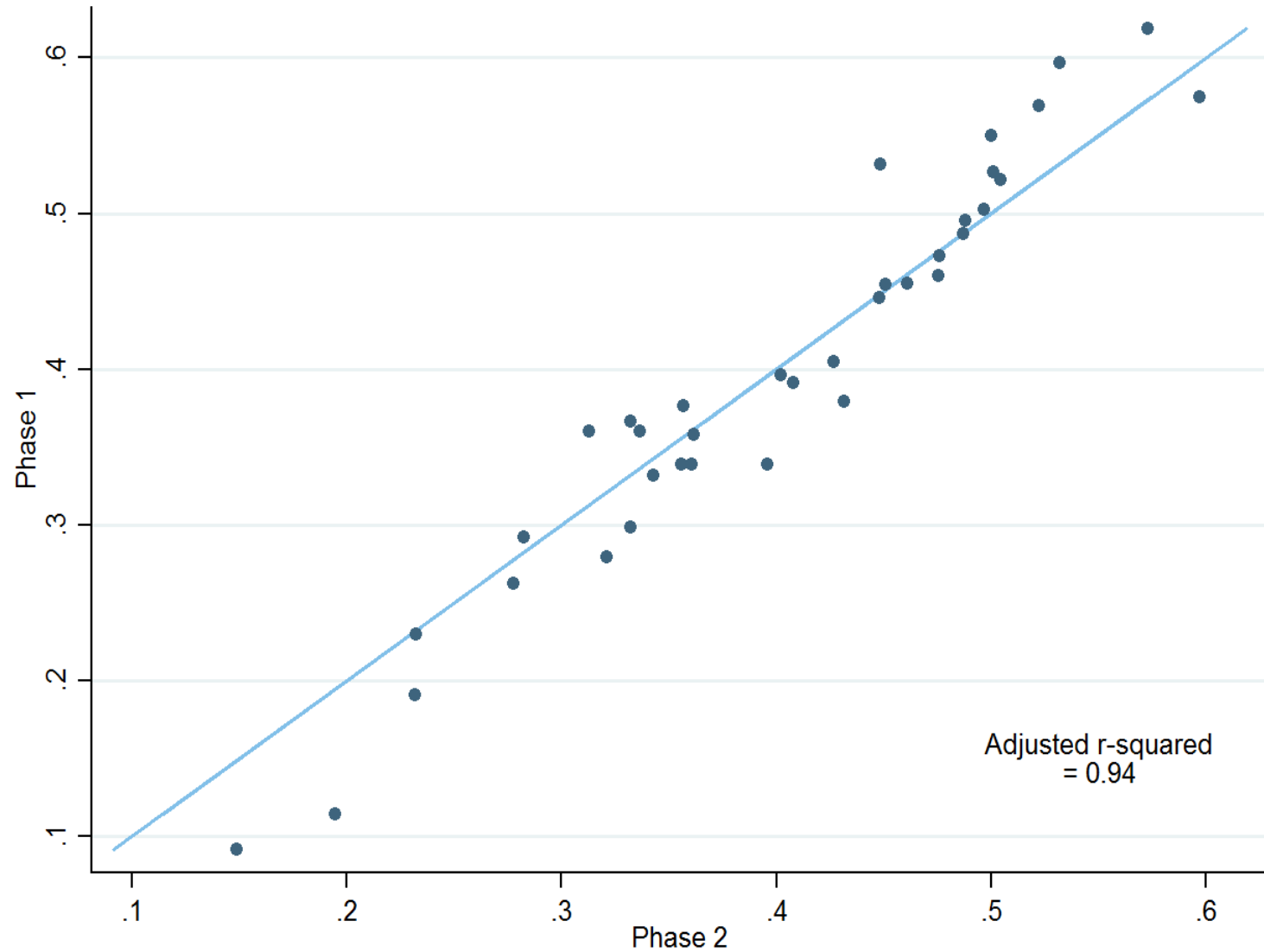
Good response rate

phase 2: n 351

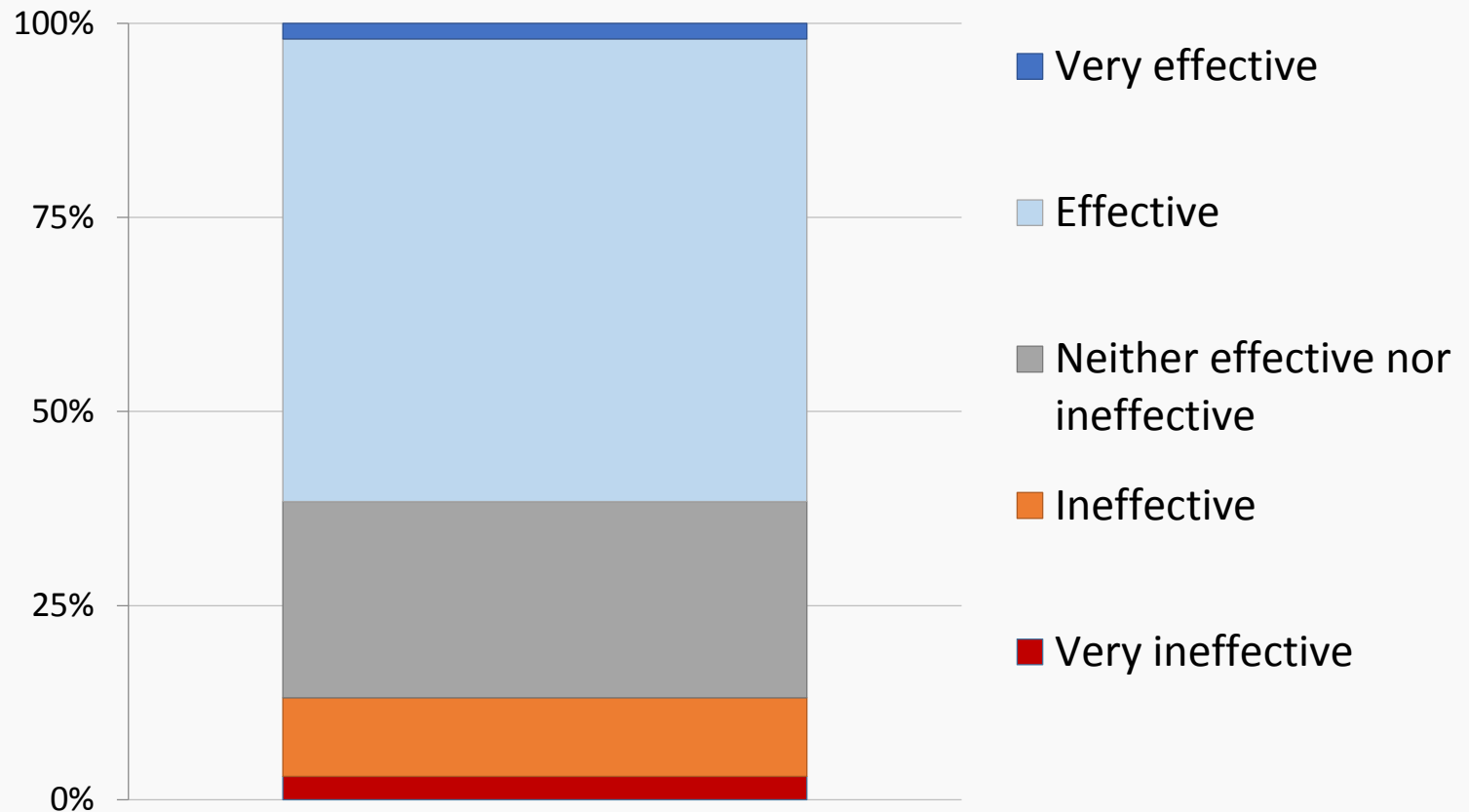

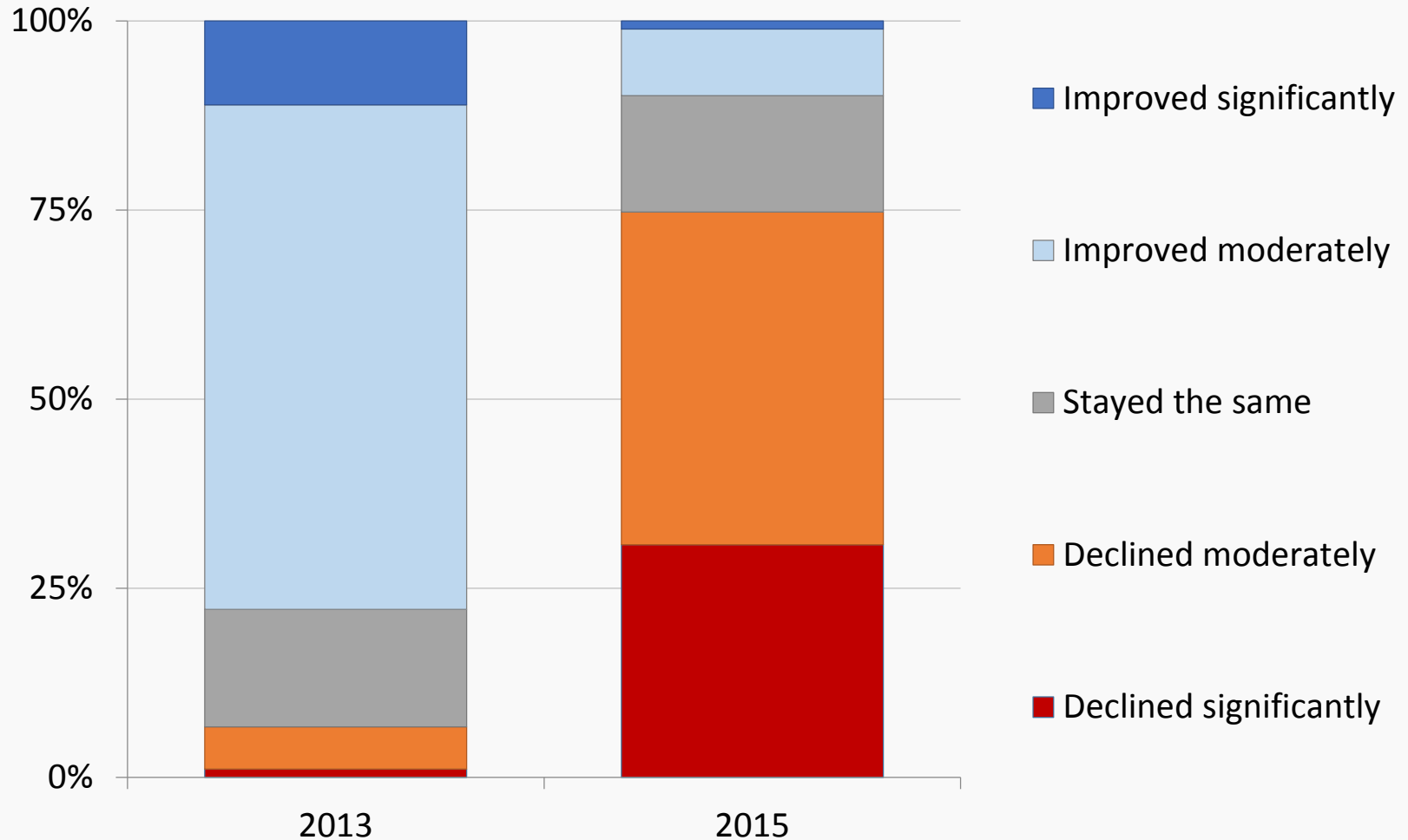

How would you rate the effectiveness of the Australian aid program? (2015)

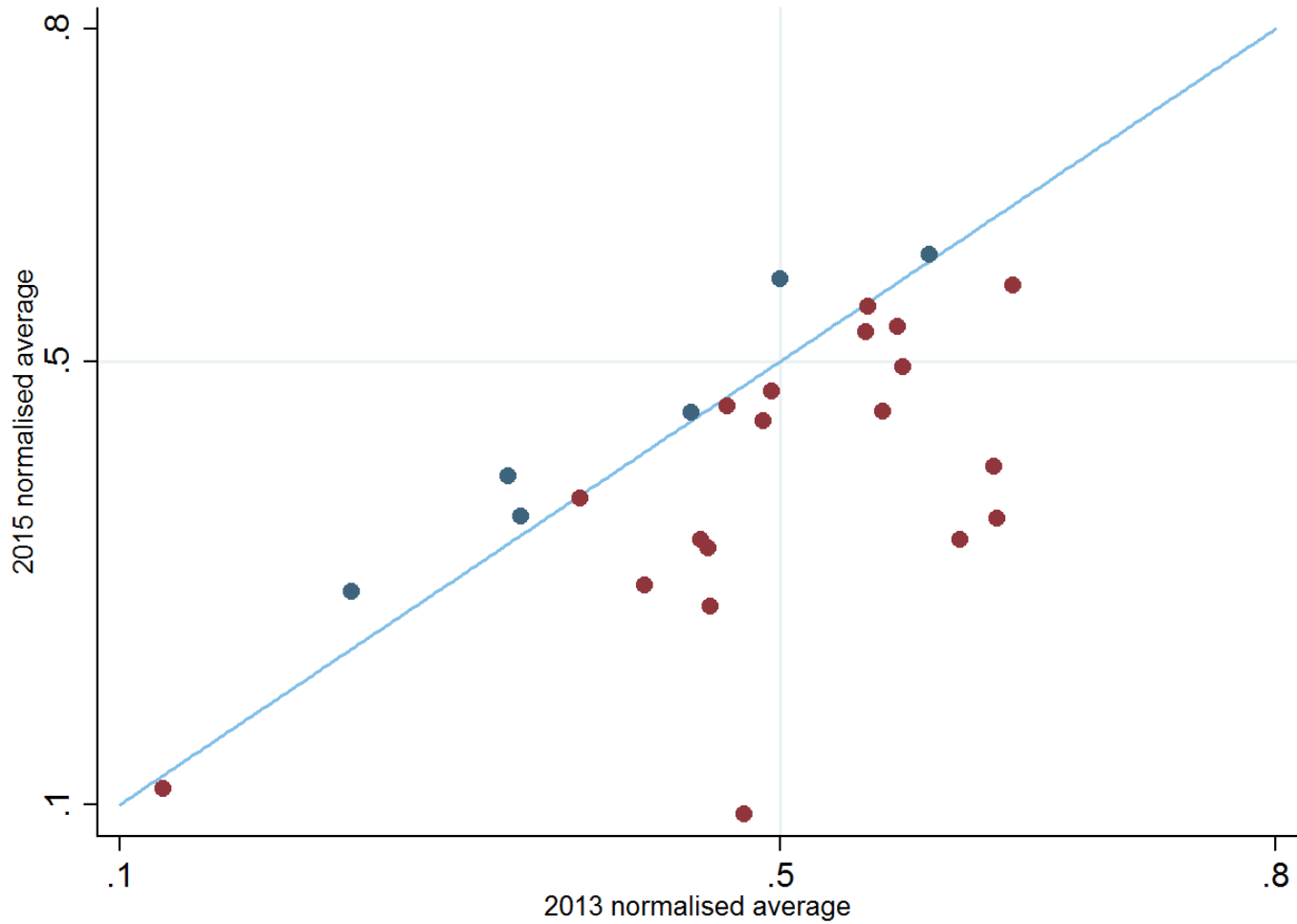


No longer getting better; getting worse

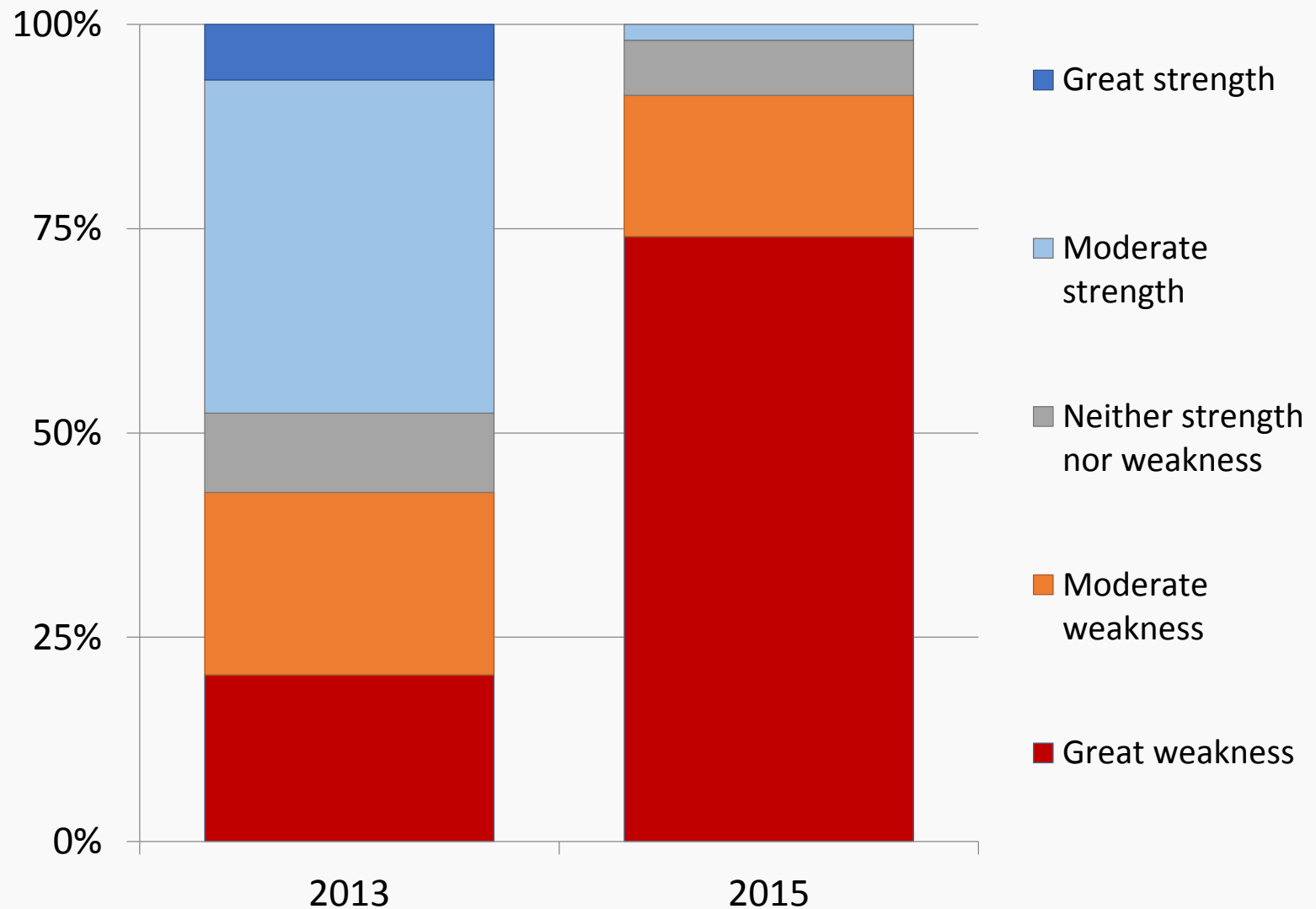
Effectiveness improved or declined (10yrs 2013 / 2yrs 2015)



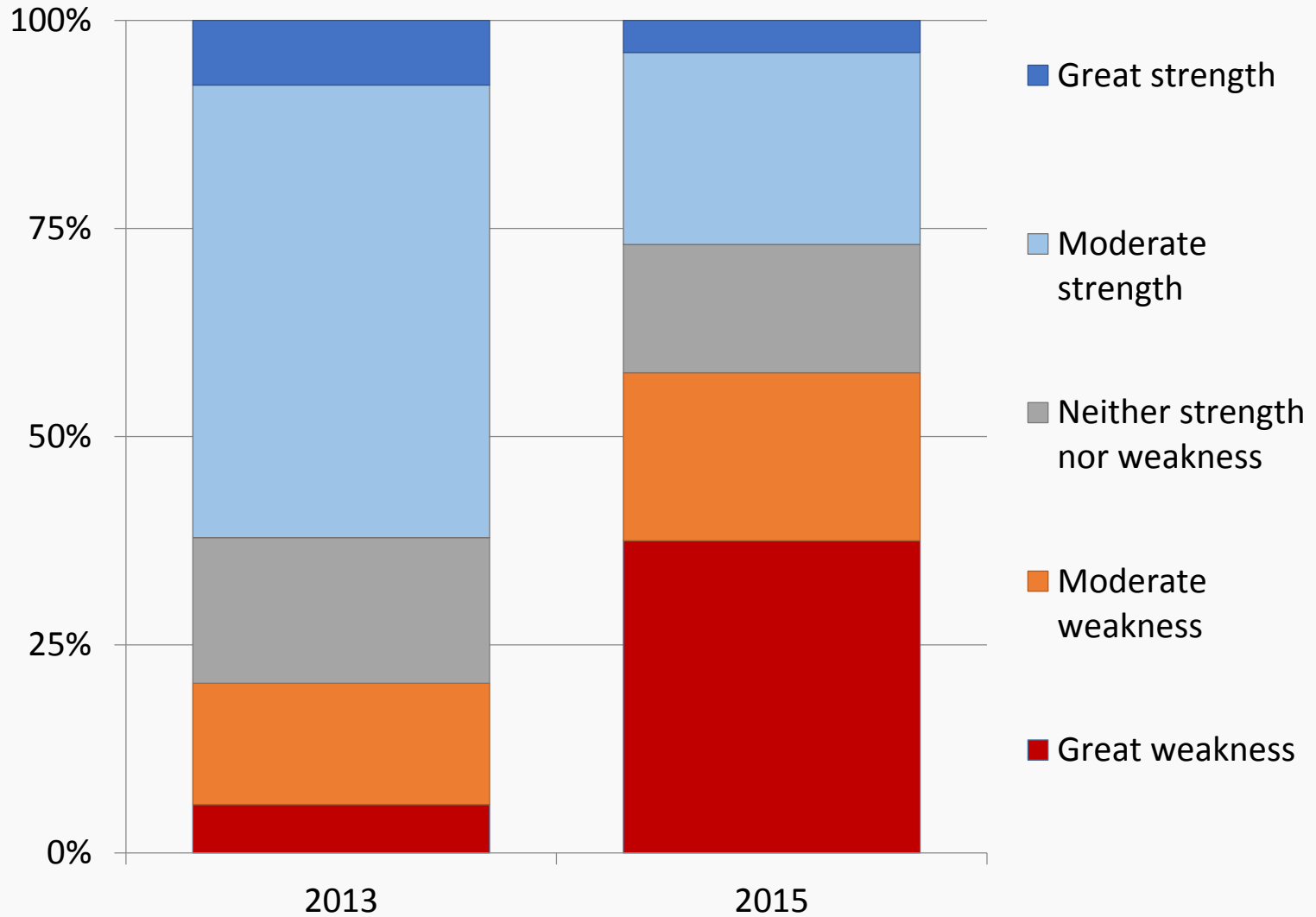
Most aspects of aid program worse



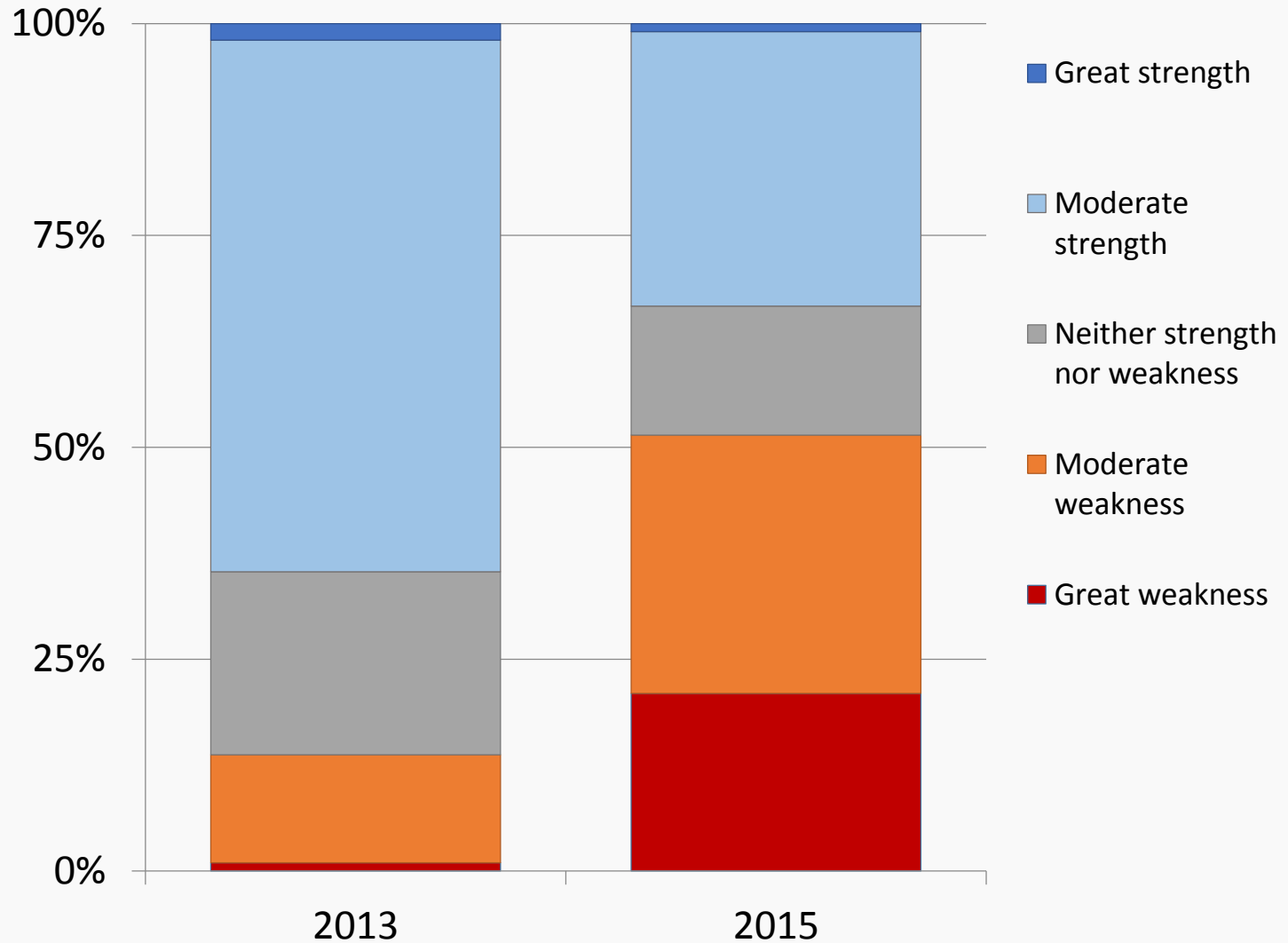
Funding predictability has collapsed



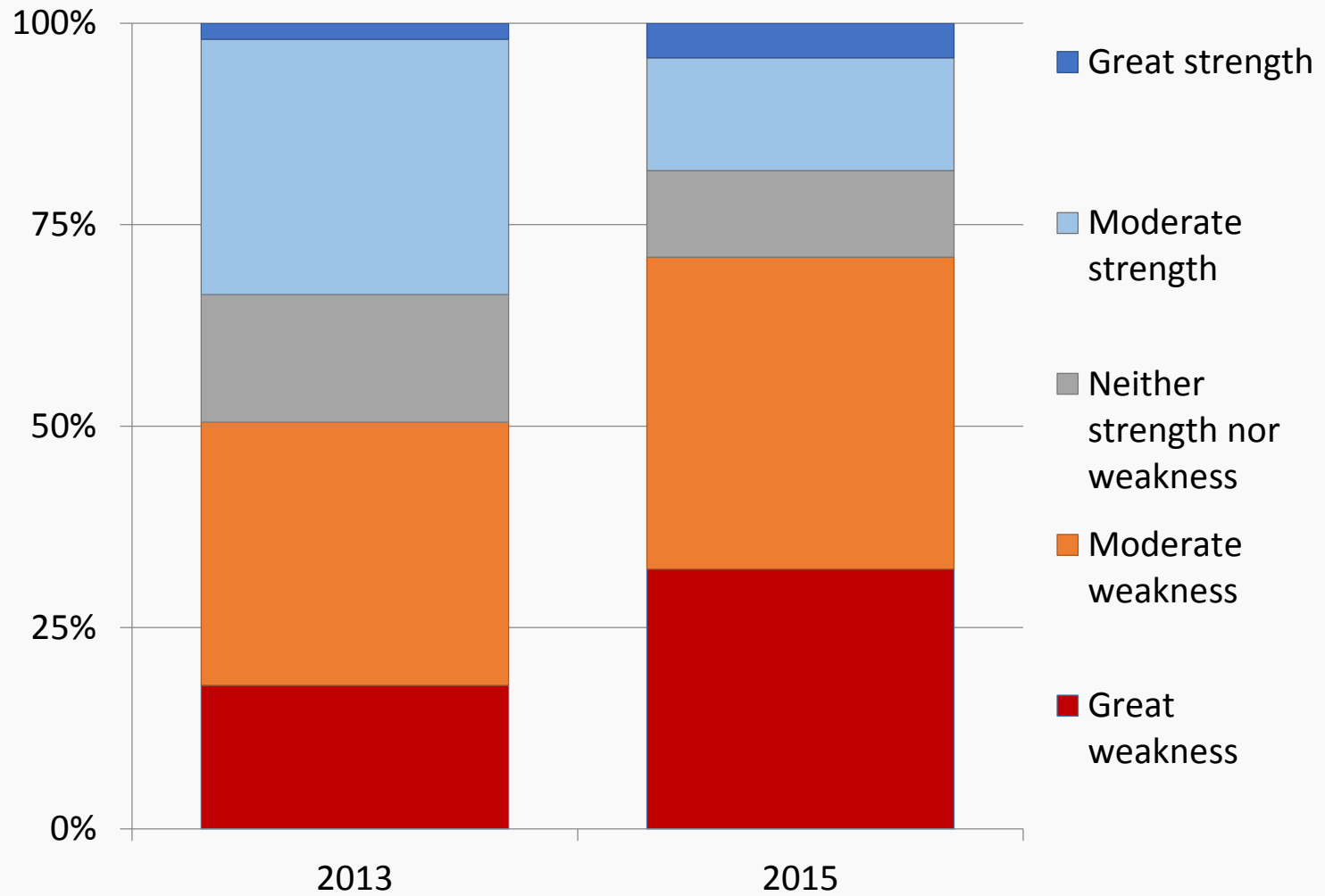

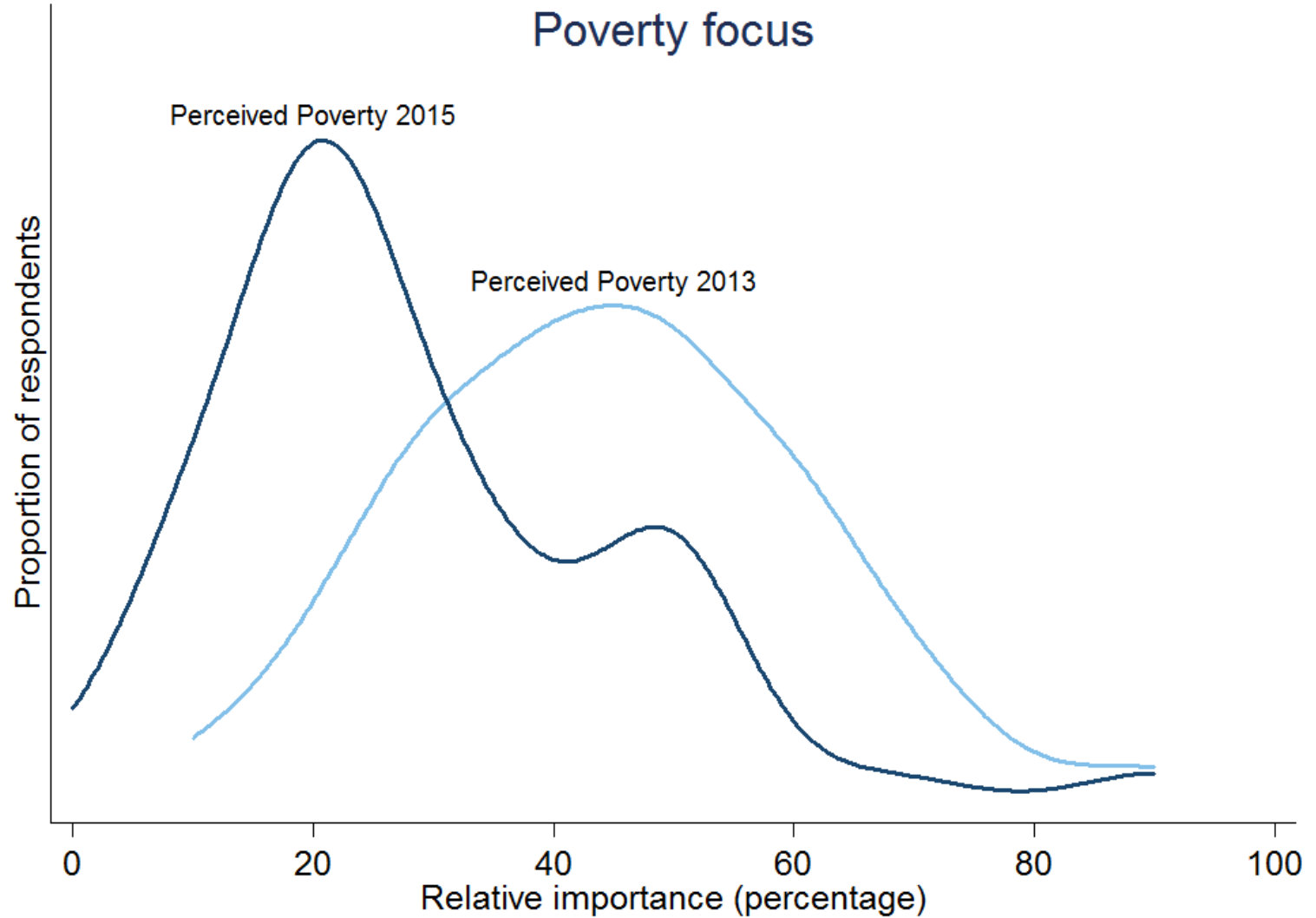

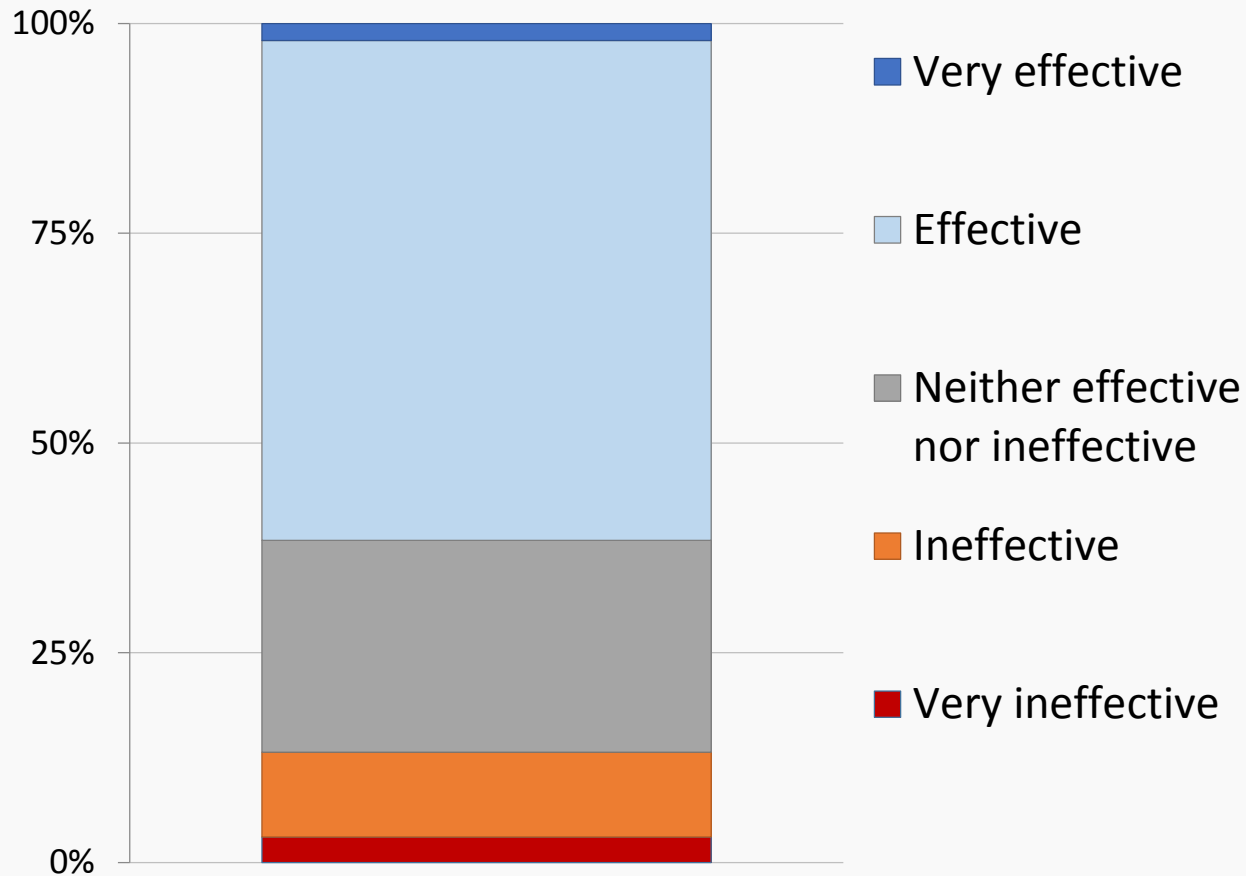

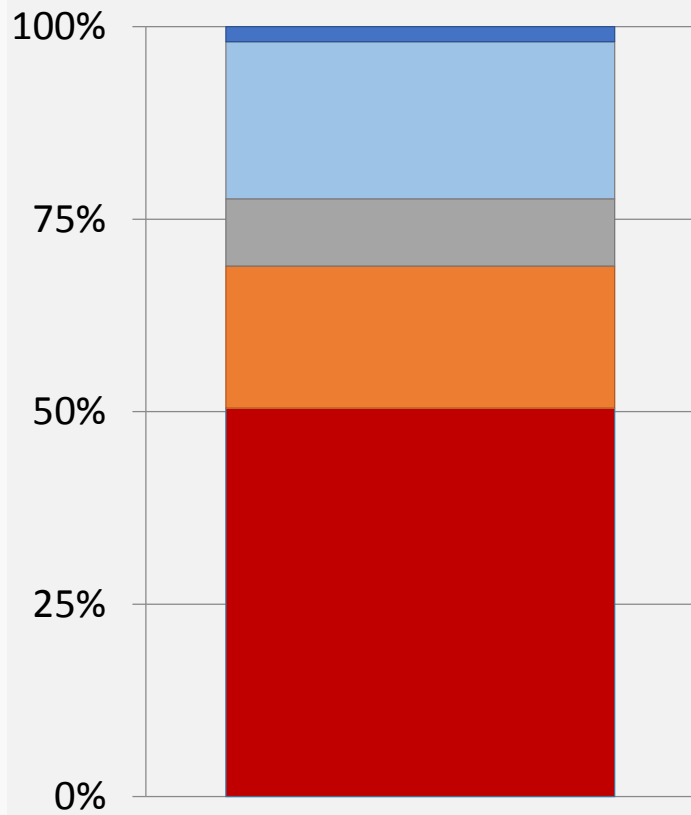

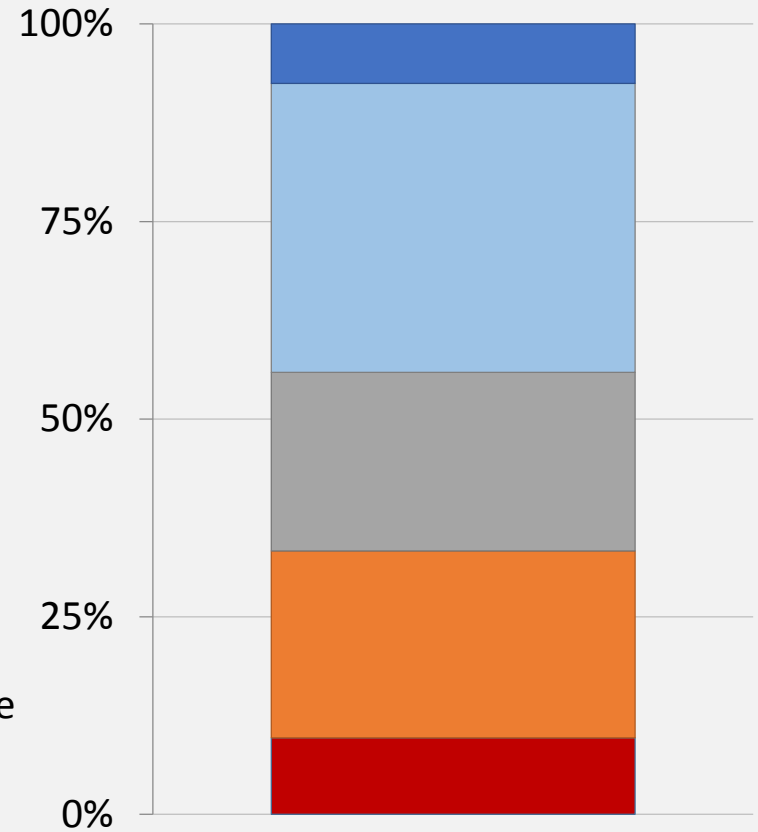
